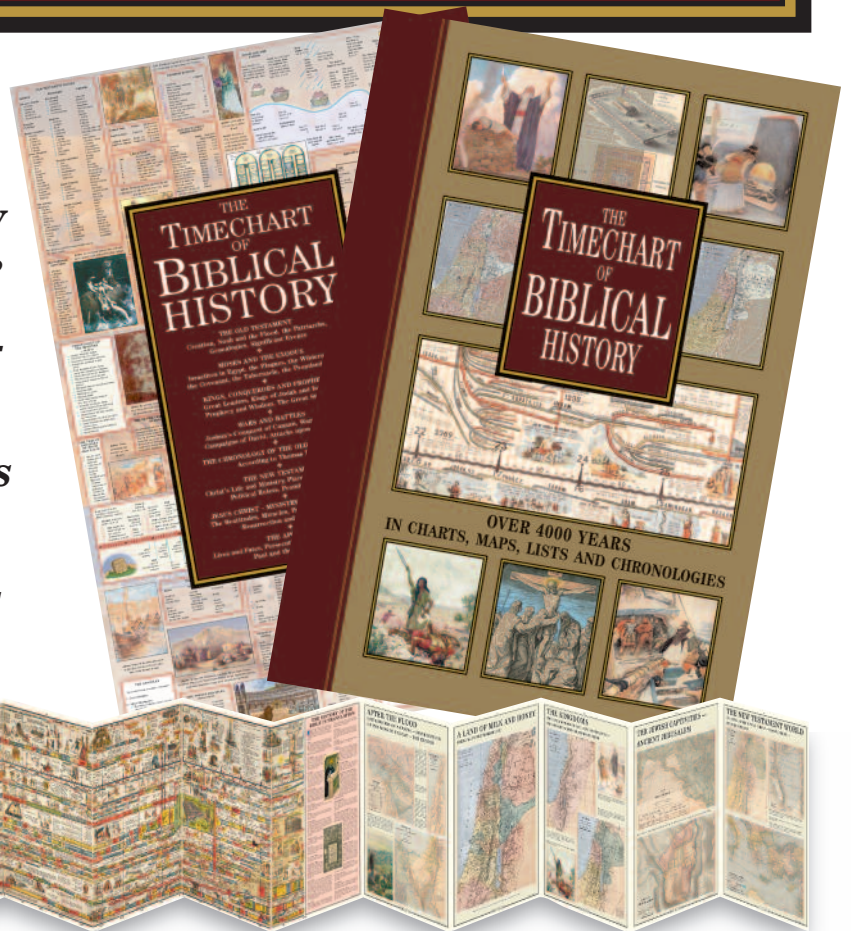

The Timechart of Biblical History is a clear and graphic way for readers of all ages to follow the narrative flow of the Bible.

With thousands of insights, text references and Victorian illustrations capturing the flavour of these great stories, *The Timechart of Biblical History* brings to life the characters and events that have helped shape Western civilization.

The TIMECHART itself is easy to use. The main Timeline runs horizontally right through the chart, divided into 100- and 10-year sections and clearly marked with dates. In addition, the traditional Creation dates are shown above the century posts. For quick reference, dates are also given at the bottom of the chart.

Coloured stream-lines show the family tree from Adam to Moses, as well as Christ's genealogy. To make it easy to relate the Bible to principal events of the Ancient world, coloured streams show various powers and nations appearing, growing bolder, dividing or being absorbed by others as time goes on.

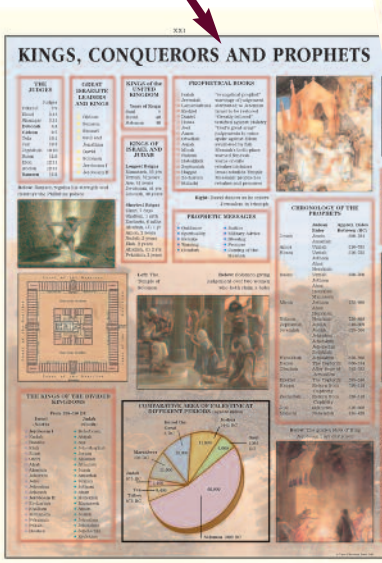
